Connie's two-day seminars focus on understanding how dogs learn and enhancing communication between dog and handler. She is passionate about helping people at all levels of the sport.

The seminar will begin with a discussion on how dogs learn. Then Connie spends time working individually with working teams. Day One normally focuses on teaching and problem solving focused on foundational topics (e.g., heeling, retrieving, recalls). Day Two typically focuses on problem solving in the context of more advanced tasks (e.g., go-outs, articles, drop on recall).

About Connie: Connie Cleveland-Nolan is an internationally recognized dog trainer who has been teaching and coaching dog obedience students for over three decades. In 2019, Connie launched The Obedience Road, a complete online resource for obedience competitors. Using written & video content, monthly webinars, community forums and personalized video review, Connie coaches obedience newcomers and experienced competitors alike.
