#### **DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to all dogs 1 year or older for ATT that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the ATT. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs are allowed to enter ATT so long as the dog is under the handler's control at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the test, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

Dogs with disabilities may participate in the ATT test. However, if a dog has multiple disabilities (e.g., blind and deaf), such that it is unable to perform more than one whole category of the test (such as auditory stimuli and visual stimuli), the dog will not earn the ATT title. If the dog has one disability (e.g., deaf), it may be tested.

The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. #### REFUNDS
