INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

ENTRY FEE: TDX \$150.00, TD \$75.00 (Includes AKC Recording Fee of \$0.50 and AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00)

TDX: Only dogs that have earned the title of AKC Tracking Dog, or Tracking Dog Urban, are eligible for entry in this Tracking Dog Excellent Test. Entries of dogs that have already earned the TDX title will be accepted only in the event that the limit is not filled by dogs that have not yet passed an AKC Tracking Dog Excellent Test. (tracking regs: Chapter 4, section 1)

TD: Entries of dogs that have already earned a TD or TDU title will be accepted only in the event that the limit is not filled by dogs that have not yet passed an AKC Tracking Dog Test. (tracking regs: Chapter 3, section 1). Those without a TD/TDU title must include one certification certificate, which will be returned if you do not draw into the test or withdraw and are replaced by an alternate.

Competition is offered for AKC Canine partners program dogs (mixed breeds.)

“Effective for all events held on and after January 1, 2008, The American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.) The current 50 cent recording will continue to be collected. The event-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Event Service Fees for the American Kennel Club. That fact shall be stated in the premium list. These event service and recording fees shall be forwarded to the American Kennel Club along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.” American Kennel Club Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Ch. 11, Sec. 2

Entries which pass an AKC approved test after the closing date of this test may withdraw from this test with full refund provided the appropriate test secretary is notified in writing not less than three days before the test date and there is an alternate to replace the entry.

In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if any alternates are present and decide according to their previously assigned position on the alternate list which of such entries shall participate.

The TD Test will begin with the drawing for tracks at 8:15 AM EDT, at the AADTC Wight Training Building, Sunday, 11 October 2026.

The TDX Test will begin with the drawing for tracks at 9:45 AM EST, at the AADTC Wight Training Building, Sunday, 8 November 2026.

Bitches in season may participate. (Ch.2, Sec. 8)

Trophies: Each dog passing the TDX Test, or passing the TD Test, shall receive a rosette at the test and shall receive an engraved plaque, to be mailed after the test.

The test worker draw option, as allowed by the AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 17d, will be used in the TDX and TD tests. 1 TDX track and 3 TD tracks will be reserved for workers. The AADTC Worker's Certificate must be submitted with the entry form to qualify. The worker draw will be held immediately prior to the regular draw. Those not succeeding in the worker draw will be in the regular draw.
